Chairman's Welcome

A Warm Welcome to the 2019 Amber Valley CAMRA Beer and Cider Festival



Welcome to this year's Festival at Strutts Community Centre, Amber Valley's tenth Festival and the sixth at Strutts from Thursday 26th to Saturday 28th September. The building has been described as "quirky" and it isn't an obvious venue for a Beer Festival, but I think it works and I'd like to thank the staff at Strutts for their help and co-operation.

We have made a number of changes this year. We are opening on Thursday from 12 noon (previously 4pm) because there appears to be a demand for a Thursday afternoon session. Furthermore Thursday will be free admission for everyone up to 6pm, not just for CAMRA members. Previously we opened on Sunday lunchtime, but this session was not well supported so we will not open on Sunday this year. We are switching from tokens to cash this year, principally because feedback suggests that customers prefer cash. As well as cash, we are hoping to be able to offer the facility of contactless payment.

The rise in popularity of Key Keg continues, so this time we will be running a small Key Keg bar. This is in no way intended to detract from, but rather to complement the range of some 60 Real Ales we will have on offer. Ditto gin; it may not be my cup of tea but it is the drink of the moment for many these days, so we will have a gin bar. Because of this we are dropping fruit wines, but there will be

a fine selection of ciders, including fruit flavours. We would very much like your feedback (positive or negative) on these changes which can be registered at the Membership Desk.

Our catering will be provided by Farmhouse Kitchen with hot and cold food at all sessions, as well as snacks available at the cider bar. As with previous years Thursday will be a quiet day, but with our popular quiz in the evening. There will be live music on Friday and Saturday evening, culminating in a Northern Soul disco on Saturday. Our Festival charity will be Derbyshire Blood Bikers, a vital local service which could one day prove life saving for any one of us.

I am sure you are all aware that all CAMRA Festivals are organised and run by a team of volunteers, and I would like to thank everyone who is involved with the Amber Valley Festival, in whatever capacity. Regrettably, it is getting increasingly difficult to attract enough volunteers to organise our Festival. Dates are booked for next year (September 24th – 26th, here at Strutts), and I sincerely hope that it will go ahead. However, without fresh volunteers the prospects are not good, so if you feel you could help please let us know.

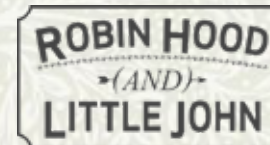

Amber Valley CAMRA runs annual Pub of the Year and Cider Pub of the Year competitions covering all pubs in our Branch area that serve real ale or real cider; we aim to involve as many members as possible in making these choices.

This year's winner of both our Branch competitions was the Talbot in Ripley. The runner-up in the Pub of the Year competition was the White Hart at Bargate, who had won the competition in the previous two years. The runner-up in the Cider Pub of the Year competition was Angels Micro Pub, Belper. Many congratulations to Steve and Angie at the Talbot for their double success and also to the runners-up in both competitions.



It will soon be time for our members to get involved again and help us to choose the entrants for the 2020 competitions. We will be sending out emails to all Amber Valley CAMRA members inviting them to nominate pubs in the Branch area which they feel deserve to be included in each competition. If you are a member and don't get these emails, it means that we don't hold a current email address for you so please email membership@ambervalley.camra.org.uk

Our Chairman Chris Rogers, along with Branch member Luke Bettison, both local cider makers, will again be organising the Cider Pub of the Year competition. Nominations will be collected



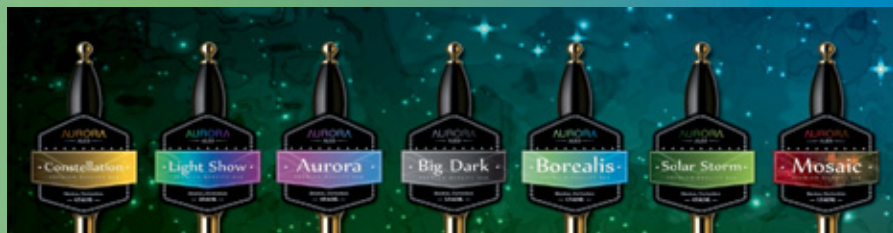
throughout October and judging of the 6 finalists will take place in November. Pubs nominated for the Cider competition would be expected to serve and promote a good range of real ciders and perries throughout the year.

The 2020 Branch Pub of The Year competition will be organised by ourselves and we will be asking for nominations during November, with judging of the 8 finalists taking place during December and January. The Pub of the Year is not based solely on the range of real ale on offer, but takes into account several other factors such as the welcome you receive, quality of service, atmosphere, décor and community involvement.

Whilst only Amber Valley members can nominate pubs, CAMRA members from any branch are welcome to take part in the judging process for each competition. This involves visiting each of the finalists at least once and completing a scoresheet based on national CAMRA guidelines. 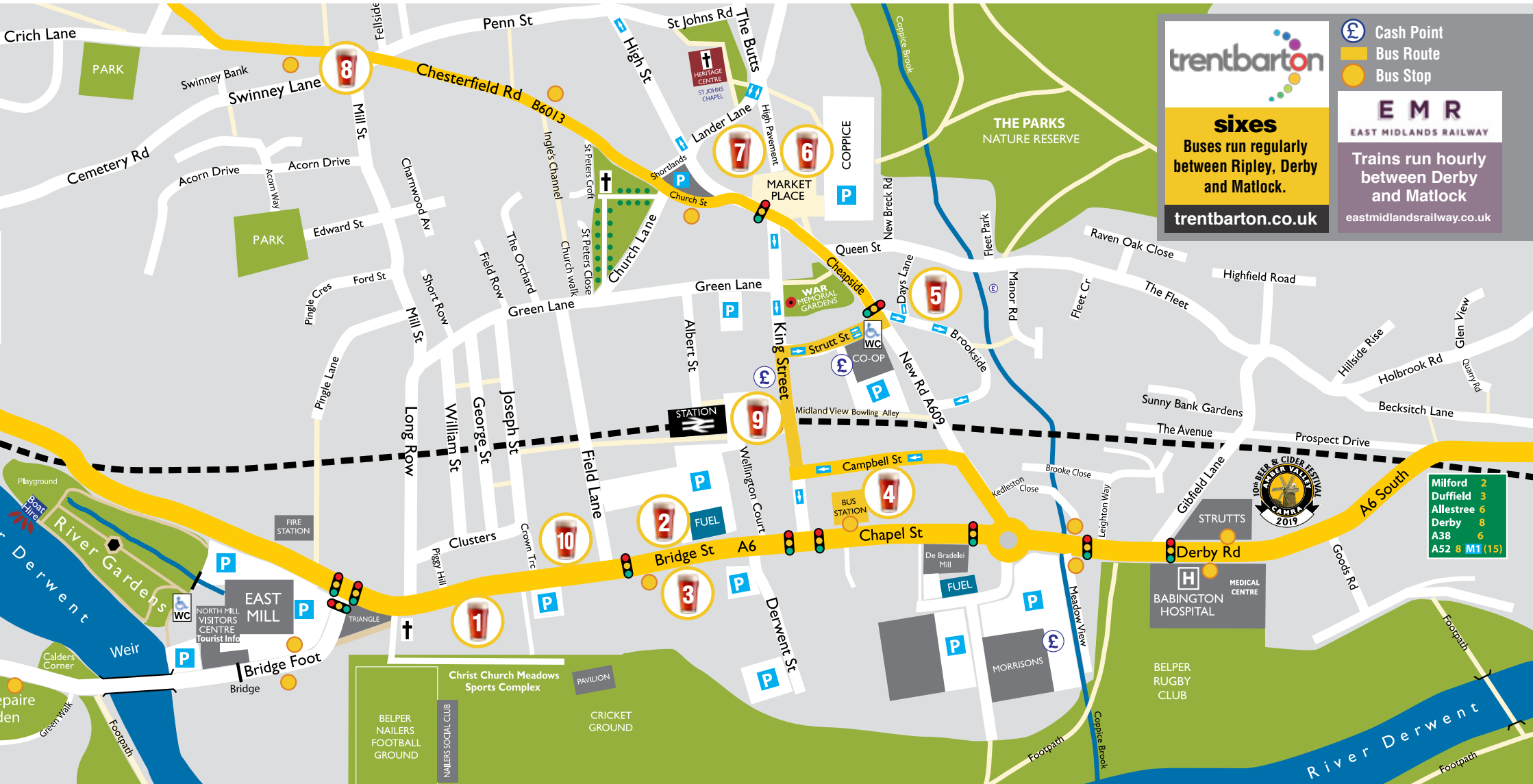

Cider & Perry

Welcome to the cider & perry bar. All the ciders and perries sold here are "Real" in the sense that they consist principally of fermented apple or pear juice respectively, however some will be flavoured with other fruits. We have three local ciders, the rest come from two of the main cider and perry producing counties, Herefordshire and Somerset, plus the ever popular Black Dragon from Gwynt y Ddraig. The ciders / perries are not artificially carbonated or served under gas pressure.

This means that the majority are still, although because they contain live yeast the residual fermentation may produce a slight sparkle. They may be clear or hazy in appearance, but not seriously opaque!



The tub labels are colour coded green for cider and yellow for perry. They have all been sampled and categorized as Very Dry, Dry, Medium Dry, Medium, Medium Sweet, Sweet or Very Sweet. Admittedly this is a bit subjective but it should help when ordering, bearing in mind that most commercially produced ciders are medium sweet or sweet. Our knowledgeable staff will be happy to discuss the ciders with you and to give small tastes provided the bar is not too busy.

Soft drinks are available, free when added as mixers to cider or for designated drivers. The main catering van is on the car park, but for those getting hungry we have a range of crisps and snacks on this bar.

WhatPub – what it is and how to use it effectively, so please read on.

WhatPub is CAMRA's national online pub guide. It can be used to search for pubs and clubs across the UK and then look up opening times, descriptions, facilities and details of the real ale and cider on offer. It is particularly useful when visiting a new area or during holidays in the UK as you can search by town name. You can also search by pub name; it can also show you a basic Google map of the location and includes additional details on food availability, car parking, bus & train connections, beer gardens, music events, pub games and TV sport. Non Camra members can use WhatPub to search for information but cannot submit updates or score beer.

We aim to regularly update the entries for each of the pubs and clubs in our branch area so they all have up-to-date information, descriptions and photos. There are around 120 **WhatPub** entries of pubs currently serving real ales in the Amber Valley Branch area to maintain, so this is quite a task and we rely on CAMRA members to provide new and additional updated information, especially in less well visited areas.

CAMRA members can also use **WhatPub** to score the quality of a pub's beers and submit these online. These scores are then used to help decide whether the pub will appear in CAMRA's annual Good Beer Guide publication, the latest edition of which will be available to buy at the festival.

How can you help?

If you are a CAMRA member, please login to WhatPub to review the pub's **WhatPub** entry. Please check that the listed beer offering is correct and also the opening times and facilities – it is very frustrating to visit a pub that is not open at the times

stated or has a different range of ales and facilities than currently entered on **WhatPub**. The easiest way to do this is to use your mobile phone web browser and visit www.WhatPub.com but you can also access with your PC, laptop or tablet. Amendments to pub details can be made using the 'Submit Updates' tab plus submission of beer scores using the 'Submit Beer Scores' tab.

WhatPub is not an iPhone or Android app but if you add a shortcut to your homepage linking to **WhatPub** it makes it easy to access every time you visit a pub.

Local CAMRA members can help by checking details of all branch pubs they visit and submitting updates via **WhatPub** or contact our Pubs Officer directly at datacoordinator@ambervalley.camra.org.uk

Either way the updates will reach the Pubs Officer who will then update the WhatPub entry.

Please help us to help other CAMRA members and pub or club users by keeping the Pubs Officer updated on any changes to our branch pubs and clubs. Thanks for your assistance.
